### A Light in Darkness

***“The Lord is my light and my salvation; whom shall I fear? the Lord is the strength of my life; of whom shall I be afraid?” Psalm 27:1 (KJV)***

Darkness has no power where He reigns. Let His light guide your path.

Darkness has a way of magnifying fear. Whether it’s the darkness of uncertainty, pain, loss, or spiritual struggle, it can feel over whelming—like there is no clear path forward. But David begins this psalm with a bold declaration, not of his circumstances, but of his confidence in God: *“The Lord is my light.”*

Light does more than simply illuminate—it reveals truth, dispels fear, and provides direction. When David calls the Lord his light, he is declaring that God brings clarity where there is confusion, hope where there is despair, and peace where there is anxiety. Darkness may surround him, but it does not control him.

Notice that David doesn’t say, “The Lord gives me light,” but *“The Lord is my light.”* This is personal. It’s not just about what God provides—it’s about who God is. When God Himself becomes your light, you are never truly in darkness, no matter what you face.

He also calls the Lord his *salvation* and *stronghold*. Salvation speaks of deliverance—God rescues us. A stronghold speaks of protection—God keeps us. Together, they form a powerful truth: God both saves you from danger and sustains you through it.

So David asks, *“Whom shall I fear?”* It’s not a question seeking an answer—it’s a declaration of faith. When God is your light, fear loses its grip.

#### **Reflection:**

What darkness are you facing today? Is it fear, doubt, uncertainty, or spiritual weariness? Instead of focusing on the darkness, shift your focus to the Light. God has not abandoned you—He is present, guiding, protecting, and strengthening you.

#### **Prayer:**

Lord, You are my light in every dark place. When fear rises, remind me that You are my salvation and my stronghold. Help me to trust in Your presence and walk confidently in Your truth. Shine Your light on my path and in my heart. In Jesus’ name, amen.

#### **Takeaway:**

You don’t have to fear the darkness when you are walking with the Light.
