### Walking by Faith

**“For we walk by faith, not by sight:” 2 Corinthians 5:7, KJV**

**Scripture:** Faith moves us beyond what we see. God calls you to trust His unseen plan. Every step of faith pleases Him.

Life often places us in situations where what we *see* does not match what God has *said*. The bills may be higher than the bank account. The diagnosis may look discouraging. The door may seem closed. Yet Paul reminds believers that our walk with God is not guided by visible evidence, but by confident trust in His promises.

To walk by faith means we trust God’s character over our circumstances. Faith is not denial of reality; it is confidence in a greater reality — that God is sovereign, present, and working even when we cannot see it. Sight focuses on the problem; faith focuses on the Provider. Sight measures obstacles; faith measures God’s power.

Faith is a daily walk, not a single leap. Each step requires surrender. Each decision requires trust. Abraham walked by faith when he left his homeland. Peter walked by faith when he stepped out of the boat. We walk by faith when we choose obedience over fear, prayer over panic, and hope over despair.

When you cannot trace God’s hand, trust His heart. What you see may change, but who God is never changes.

**Prayer:**

Lord, help me to walk by faith and not by sight. When circumstances seem uncertain, anchor my heart in Your promises. Teach me to trust You step by step, knowing You are leading the way. Amen.
